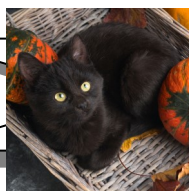

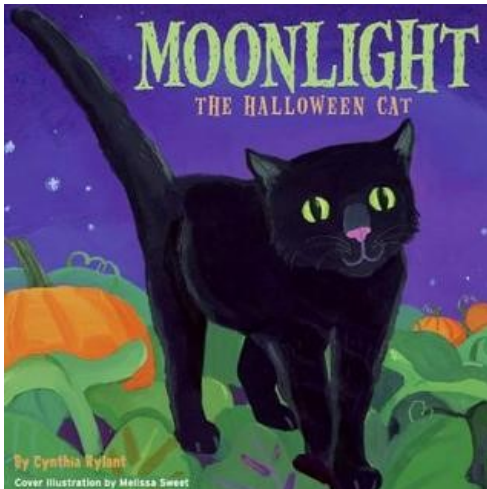

What is a Hotspot?

A Hotspot is a device you can use to connect your smartphone, tablet, or laptop to the Internet. Hotspots are portable, so you can access the Internet wherever you are.

What is a Chromebook?

A Chromebook is like a regular laptop except that it doesn't run on a Windows operating system. It doesn't have Word, PowerPoint, or Excel, but it has similar apps. You can type your paper on Google Docs, create your class presentation on Google Slides, and make your spreadsheets on Google Sheets.
